CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT TIMES

WIFI DETAILS

There is no WiFi available, and Telstra is the only service provider which works. The bush nurses (across the road) does have a free "Community Wifi" connection. There is no password needed for this

HOUSE RULES

We kindly ask you to read our house rules carefully and keep them in mind during your stay.

1. No parties or events allowed.
2. No smoking allowed.
3. Pets are allowed – please ensure they are not on the furniture
4. Suitable for toddlers and children under 12.
5. No unregistered guests allowed.
6. Please don't eat or drink in the bedrooms.
7. Please respect the neighbours
8. Please turn off the AC when you go out.
9. Please respect check-in and check-out times.
10. Please take extra care of your keys. Lost keys incur a replacement fee of \$50.
11. Please take care of the furnishings. You have to pay for damages that exceed the security deposit.
12. Please don't rearrange the furniture.
13. Please do your dishes, the dishwasher should be stacked and turned on when checking out
14. There are 2 rubbish bins at the back door. One for landfill rubbish and one for recycling
15. No illegal substances allowed on the premises.

HOW TO USE APPLIANCES

Air conditioning:

You can adjust the temperature using the remote control on the living room wall – please ensure the remote is placed back in its holder once used, don't leave the A/C running when you leave the house.

Washer:

The washer is in the European laundry. You'll find the user manual in the house compendium

Coffee pod machine:

Capsules are in the pantry.

Dishwasher:

You'll find the dishwasher tablets in a glass jar under the kitchen counter. The most efficient program to use is the one labelled 'Eco' - press power and press start – super simple

Outdoor adventure

the surrounding region. Dargo is the perfect base for a day trip taking in the spectacular scenery of the High Plains and the Grant Historic area.

Agriculture

Dargo is known for its groves of century-old walnut trees that line the valley floor. Many high-country cattlemen have homes in the stockbreeding and agricultural district.

History

Although a minor gold rush was experienced in the mid 1800s, the town was primarily a resting place and later a supply town for miners on their way to the Grant, Talbotville and Crooked River goldfields nearby.

For a dose of living history, grab a pint at the Dargo Hotel, established all the way back in 1898.
